"But what about you?" he asked.

"Who do you say I am?" Peter

answered, "You are the Messiah."

(Mk 8:29, NIV)





He then began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and after three days rise again. (Mk 8:31, NIV)





In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence. 14 He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed. (Dn 7:13-14, NIV)





Again the high priest asked him, "Are you the Messiah, the Son of the Blessed One?"

62 "I am," said Jesus. "And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven." (Mk 14:61b-62, NIV)





63 The high priest tore his clothes. "Why do we need any more witnesses?" he asked. 64 "You have heard the blasphemy. What do you think?" They all condemned him as worthy of death. (Mk 14:63-64, NIV)







He spoke plainly about this, and Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. (Mk 8:32, NIV)





But he was pierced for **our** transgressions, he was crushed for **our** iniquities; the punishment that brought **us** peace was on him, and by his wounds **we** are healed. (Is 53:5, NIV)





But when Jesus turned and looked at his disciples, he rebuked Peter. "Get behind [οπίσω | opiso] me, Satan!" he said. "You do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns." (Mk 8:33, NIV)



CONTEXT RIGHT DESIGNATION, WRONG DEDICATION



Whenever the impure spirits saw him, they fell down before him and cried out, "You are the Son of God." (Mk 3:11, NIV)



CONTEXT RIGHT DESIGNATION, WRONG DEDICATION



"Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. (Mt 7:21, NIV)



CONTEXT RIGHT DESIGNATION, WRONG DEDICATION



"Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say? (Lk 6:46, NIV)



MARK 8:34 CONDITIONS FOR TRUE CHRISTIANS



And having summoned the crowd – along with His disciples – He said to them, "If anyone desires to follow behind [ὀπίσω | opisō] Me, they must deny themselves, carry their cross, and follow me [continually]. (Mk 8:34, AT)







Trust in the LORD [YHWH] with all your heart,

and on your own insight do not lean. (Pr 3:5, AT)







He who trusts in his own heart is a fool, But he who walks wisely will be delivered. (Pr 28:26, NASB)



MARK 8:34 CROSS-BEARING



Then he said to them all: "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me. (Lk 9:23, NIV)



MARK 8:35 PARADOXICAL PROMISE



For whoever desires to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for my sake and for the Gospel will save it. (Mk 8:35, AT)



MARK 8:35 PARADOXICAL PROMISE



28 Then Peter spoke up, "We have left everything to follow you!" 29 "Truly I tell you," Jesus replied, "no one who has left home or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or fields for me and the gospel 30 will fail to receive a hundred times as much in this present age: homes, brothers, sisters, mothers, children and fields—along with persecutions—and in the age to come eternal life." (Mk 10:28-30, NIV)

For what benefit is it for a person to gain the whole world and lose their soul? (Mk 8:36, AT)



MARK 8:37 NO DEAL



For what can a person give in exchange for their soul? (Mk 8:37, AT)



MARK 8:38 NO SHAME IN OUR GAME



For whoever is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when He comes in His Father's glory with the holy angels." (Mk 8:38, AT)



MARK 8:38 NO SHAME IN OUR GAME



Am I now trying to win the approval of human beings, or of God? Or am I trying to please people? If I were still trying to please people, I would not be a servant of Christ. (Gal 1:10, NIV)



MARK 8:38 NO SHAME IN OUR GAME



He replied, "Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you hypocrites; as it is written:

"These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. [Is 29:13] (Mk 7:6, NIV; cf. Tit 1:16; 1 Jn 2:3-6)

For he has set a day when he will judge the world with justice by the man he has appointed. He has given proof of this to everyone by raising him from the dead. (Ac 17:31, NIV
