Psalm 146:3-4 NIV

- 3 Do not put your trust in princes, in human beings, who cannot save.
- 4 When their spirit departs, they return to the ground; on that very day their plans come to nothing.





Psalm 146:5-7 NIV

- 5 Blessed are those whose help is the God of Jacob, whose hope is in the LORD their God.
- 6 He is the Maker of heaven and earth, the sea, and everything in them—he remains faithful forever.
- 7 He upholds the cause of the oppressed and gives food to the hungry.

 The LORD sets prisoners free,





Psalm 146:8-9 NIV

- the LORD gives sight to the blind, the LORD lifts up those who are bowed down, the LORD loves the righteous.

I. We Praise The Lord

Psalm 146:1-2 NIV

- 1 Praise the LORD [Hallelujah].
 - Praise the LORD, my soul.
- 2 I will praise the LORD all my life;

I will sing praise to my God as long as I live.





I. We Praise The Lord Psalm 147:1 NIV

Praise the LORD [Hallelujah].

How good it is to sing praises to our God, how pleasant and fitting to praise him!





I. We Praise The Lord Psalm 148:1 NIV

Praise the LORD [*Hallelujah*].

Praise the LORD from the heavens;

praise him in the heights above.





I. We Praise The Lord Psalm 149:1 NIV

Praise the LORD [Hallelujah].

Sing to the LORD a new song,

his praise in the assembly of his faithful people.





I. We Praise The Lord Psalm 150:1-3 NIV

- 1 Praise the LORD [Hallelujah].
 - Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heavens.
- 2 Praise him for his acts of power; praise him for his surpassing greatness.
- 3 Praise him with the sounding of the trumpet, praise him with the harp and lyre,





I. We Praise The Lord Psalm 150:4-6 NIV

- 4 praise him with timbrel and dancing, praise him with the strings and pipe,
- 5 praise him with the clash of cymbals, praise him with resounding cymbals.
- 6 Let everything that has breath praise the LORD. Praise the LORD.





I. We Praise The Lord Philippians 1:21 NIV

For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.





I. We Praise The Lord Colossians 3:4 NIV

When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.





I. We Praise The Lord 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 NIV

16 Rejoice always, 17 pray continually, 18 give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.





II. We Trust In The Lord Psalm 146:3-4 NIV

- 3 Do not put your trust in princes, in human beings, who cannot save.

II. We Trust In The Lord Acts 17:28 NIV

'For in him we live and move and have our being.' As some of your own poets have said, 'We are his offspring.'





II. We Trust In The Lord Jeremiah 17:5-6 NIV

- 5 This is what the LORD says:
 - "Cursed is the one who trusts in man, who draws strength from mere flesh and whose heart turns away from the LORD.
- That person will be like a bush in the wastelands; they will not see prosperity when it comes.
 - They will dwell in the parched places of the desert, in a salt land where no one lives.





II. We Trust In The Lord Jeremiah 17:7 NIV

7 "But blessed is the one who trusts in the LORD, whose confidence is in him.





II. We Trust In The Lord Proverbs 3:5-6 NIV

5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;6 in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

III. We Hope In The Lord Isaiah 40:31 NIV

31 but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength.

They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.





III. We Hope In The Lord Psalm 121:1-2 NIV

- 1 I lift up my eyes to the mountains—where does my help come from?
- 2 My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth.





Psalm 121:3-4 NIV

- 3 He will not let your foot slip
 - he who watches over you will not slumber;
- 4 indeed, he who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.





III. We Hope In The Lord Psalm 121:5-6 NIV

5 The LORD watches over you—the LORD is your shade at your right hand;6 the sun will not harm you by day,nor the moon by night.





III. We Hope In The Lord Psalm 121:7-8 NIV

- 7 The LORD will keep you from all harm—he will watch over your life;
- 8 the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.





IV. We Exalt The Lord Psalm 146:10 NIV

10 The LORD reigns forever,

your God, O Zion, for all generations.

Praise the LORD.





IV. We Exalt The Lord Revelation 11:15b NIV

"The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Messiah, and he will reign for ever and ever."





IV. We Exalt The Lord Isaiah 25:1 NIV

LORD, you are my God; I will exalt you and praise your name, for in perfect faithfulness you have done wonderful things, things planned long ago.





IV. We Exalt The Lord Philippians 2:9-11 NIV

- 9 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name,
- 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,
- 11 and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
