34 But Mary said to the angel, "How will this be since I have not had sexual intercourse with [lit. know] a man?" (Lk 1:34, AT) 35 Then the angel answered and said to her, [the] Holy Spirit will come upon you and [the] power of [the] Most High will overshadow you. And, thus, the One who is to be born will be called holy [and the] Son of God. (Lk 1:35, AT I)

36 And behold: Elizabeth – your (female) relative – she has also conceived a son in her old age. And this is [the] sixth month of she who was said to be unable to conceive [lit. called infertile]. 37 For nothing will be impossible with God. (Lk 1:36-37, AT)

And Mary said, "Behold: [I am] the servant of the Lord. May it happen to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her. (Lk 1:38, AT)



LUKE 2:1 CAESAR AUGUSTUS: KING OF THE WORLD



Now it came to pass: in those days, a decree went out from Caesar Augustus to have the entire [Roman] world register themselves for a tax census. (Lk 2:1, AT)



LUKE 2:1 CAESAR AUGUSTUS: "SON OF A GOD"?



A Priene inscription circa 9 BC hailed Caesar Augustus as a **god** whose "**birthday** signaled the beginning of **good news**

[εὐαγγέλιον | euangelion] for the world."







"[Augustus] is the father of his divine homeland Rome, inherited from his father Zeus, and a savior of the common folk...making peace for land and sea... there are fond hopes for the future and good will during the present which fills all men." (Inscription from Halicarnassus)

"Divine Augustus Caesar, son of a god, imperator of land and sea, the benefactor and savior of the whole world...." (Myrian inscription)



This is the text of the letter that the prophet Jeremiah sent from Jerusalem to the surviving elders among the exiles and to the priests, the prophets and all the other people Nebuchadnezzar had carried into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon. (Jer 29:1, NIV)







10 This is what the LORD [YHWH] says: "When seventy years are completed for Babylon, I will come to you and fulfill my good promise to bring you back to this place. 11 For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD [YHWH], "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. (Jer 29:10-11, NIV)





12 Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. 13 You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. 14 I will be found by you," declares the LORD [YHWH], "and will bring you back from captivity. 


LUKE 2:4 BETHLEHEM: CITY OF DAVID



Now David was the son of an Ephrathite named Jesse, who was from Bethlehem in Judah. Jesse had eight sons, and in Saul's time he was very old. (1 Sam 17:12, NIV)







"But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times." (Mic 5:2, NIV)




LUKE 2:4 BETHLEHEM: CITY OF THE MESSIAH



4 And having assembled all the people's chief priests and teachers of the law, he asked them where the Messiah [Christ] was to be born. 5 Then they said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judah. For so it has been written by the prophet: 6 'And you, **Bethlehem**, [in the] land of Judah are by no means least among the rulers of Judah. For out of you will come a ruler who will shepherd My people, Israel [Mic 5:2]." (Mt 2:4-6, AT)

Then it came to pass: when they were there, the days were fulfilled in order for her to give birth. (Lk 2:6, AT)

And, behold: you will conceive in your womb and give birth to a son, and you shall call His name Jesus. (Lk 1:31, AT)



LUKE 2:7 THE BEST GIFT OF HISTORY THE DELIVERER'S DELIVERY



And she gave birth to her Firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling clothes and laid Him in a manger, because there was no space for them in the lodging place [κατάλυμα | katalyma]. (Lk 2:7, AT)





10 He replied, "As you enter the city, a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him to the house that he enters, 11 and say to the owner of the house, 'The Teacher asks: Where is the **guest room** [κατάλυμα | katalyma], where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?' (Lk 22:10-11, NIV)





11 The LORD [YHWH] also said to Moses, 12 "I have taken the Levites from among the Israelites in place of the first male offspring of every Israelite woman. The Levites are mine, 13 for all the firstborn are mine. When I struck down all the firstborn in Egypt, I set apart for myself every firstborn in Israel, whether human or animal. They are to be mine. I am the LORD [YHWH]." (Num 3:11-13, NIV)





22 When the time came for the purification rites required by the Law of Moses, Joseph and Mary took him to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord 23 (as it is written in the Law of the Lord, "Every firstborn male is to be consecrated to the Lord" [Ex 13:2, 12, 15; Num 3:13]), 24 and to offer a sacrifice in keeping with what is said in the Law of the Lord: "a pair of doves or two young pigeons." [Lev 12:8] (Lk 2:22-24, NIV)
