Context Have A Christ-Like Mindset: Humble Surrender For Holy Victory

In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: (Php 2:5, NIV)







6 Who, being in very nature God,

did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage;

7 rather, he made himself nothing

by taking the very nature of a servant,

being made in human likeness.

8 And being found in appearance as a man,

he humbled himself

by becoming **obedient** to death—

even death on a cross! (Php 2:6-8, NIV)





9 **Therefore** God **exalted him** to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Therefore, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed – not only in my presence, but now even more in my absence – work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, (Php 2:12, AT)
